## PRESS RELEASE

Reference is made to the press release by the GRNMA and its allied Associations, which COHNAG was fully represented in all the negotiation meetings held. COHNAG is hereby instructing all Community Health Nurses in Ghana to fully participate in the intended industrial action schedule on Monday, 21st September, 2020.

It is worth noting that, the fight is not for only Ghana Registered Nurses and Midwives Association members alone but for all nurses in Ghana as defined in the on-going negotiation document presented to the Fair Wages and Salary Commission and our employer.

The definition of a nurse in the negotiation document presented to the above stakeholders includes: Staff Nurses, Community Health Nurses, Enrolled Nurses and all other nurses.

It is again worth noting that; GRNMA is the only body with **Bargaining Certificate** in the nursing fraternity and its allied Associations in Ghana.

In line with the above, we urge all managers not to intimidate our members and allow them to exercise their membership right as nurses.

This serves to inform managers who have begun issuing words of threat to our members to desist from such act as the Association will not countenance with such action. Ghana is a democratic nation; citizens therefore must not be intimidated but be allowed to exercise their citizenship rights as Ghanaians.
