


INNOVATIONS ON THROAT CANCER AWARENESS CREATION, SCREENING AND VACCINATION IN KETU-NORTH AND BEYOND

Throat cancer

- Beware of the risk factors
- Survivor sounds alarm bell

A THROAT cancer survivor has advised anyone who experiences persistent hoarseness of voice, swelling around the neck, difficulty in breathing and swallowing food to report to any health facility for investigation.

Mary Amankwah Fordwor, who is now championing efforts to prevent throat cancer, said detecting some throat was also a risk factor.

The throat cancer survivor, who came from an artificial voice embankment

device with a pipe starting from his neck, explained that those might be signs and symptoms of throat cancer, therefore, going to the health facility for early diagnosis and treatment could help reduce the risk of the condition and also save lives.

"I wish we will keep self-medication. One must wait until it's too late. Early detection saves lives. Go to the doctor to tell you it's nothing rather than sleeping at home and
