

# **DOMANGYILI CHPS**

## **INNOVATIVE PROJECTS**

Domangyili community was a community with low knowledge on health issues and there was a measles outbreak in 2013 with over ten (10) children affected. Due to that, a CHPs compound was built and launched in 2015.

When I started the CHPs compound in 2015, five (5) pregnant women came for first ANC registration in November and two (2) were in second trimester and three (3) in third trimester.

I started serious health education on all aspect of health.

The establishment of delivery rooms was driven by the desire to reduce maternal and infant mortality rates, which was high in the past due to low knowledge in health and lack of proper medical care and facilities. Once their attitude towards health was encouraging, I decided to engaged them with the idea of building delivery rooms to support the existing structure.

As we speak, we had eight ANC registrants in February, 2025 and all were within first trimester and 99.9% facility delivery as compared to around 40% at the beginning of the CHPs operation.

## **FIVE (5) UNITS OF DELIVERY ROOMS**

It is a community self-initiated project. This vision was shared by the CHO, Biiso Isaiah Ansonnama with CHMC and other opinion leaders on 15/03/2021 during a CHMC meeting. Everyone present accepted the vision, since they knew the CHPs compound has one room for consultation, ANC, delivery, FP Services etc.

During our first quarter durbar on 25/03/2021, this shared vision and pressing need was made known to the community members. It was accepted wholeheartedly and contributions started on that very day. Men were made to contribute **GH¢ 20.00** and women **GH¢ 10.00**. it was repeated for third quarter 2021. community members play a crucial role in this phase as they rally support and contribute to the fundraising efforts.

With funding secured, the actual construction begins. Our then district director of health services, Mr. Clifford Vengkumwin came with the Wa West District engineer to join the local contractors to design the building plan.

Throughout the construction process, the community members were their own local contractors, laborers and volunteers working to bring the vision to life.

During the course of building, we receive support from some individuals such as fifty (50) bags of cement from Hon. Patrick Bandanaa Pharok (Former Aspirant for NDC Primaries in 2019), two packets of alu zinc from Mr. Zoyaari Felix (Businessman in Nyoli), Ten Thousand Ghana Cedis (GH¢ 10,000.00) from Hon. Peter Lanchene Tuubo (MP for Wa West Constituency).

**CONSTRUCTION OF A BOREHOLE AND MECHANIZATION AT DOMANGYILI CHPS**

Domangyili CHPS is one of the CHPs compounds in Wa West District without a borehole at the CHPs premises.

Through my cordial relationship with Hon. Claudius Dari, Assembly Member for Sanuori Electoral Area, he linked me up and I wrote a proposal to the ROTARY CLUB, WA for construction of a borehole at the CHPS compound.

On 20/08/2024, a positive reply was given by the ROTARY CLUB, WA that they will be coming to Domangyili to have a meeting with community leaders which they did on 24/08/2024.

The drilling of the borehole commenced on 02/09/2024.

Mechanization is on the process and handing over will be done by ending of march. 2025.
