CENTRAL REGION ELECTS NEW EXECUTIVES

The long awaited Central Regional GRNMA election has been conducted. The elections brought an end to a two-year leadership crisis in the region. The National Executive Committee with the approval of the National Council of the GRNMA had to extend the tenure of the sitting executives to enable the association to run in the region while issues concerning the elections were settled in court. In a statement, Mr. Alfred Addy, the Chairman elect for the region thanked delegates and praised his opponents for showing good comradeship and promised to bring on board all members to ensure the association achieves its goals.

The National Executive Committee (NEC) led by the President, Mrs. Perpetual Ofori-Ampofo, paid a courtesy call on the Vice President on the 23rd September, 2021 to formally invite him to the Association's 18th Biennial National Delegates Conference, discuss other pertinent issues related to the profession and to also sympathize with him on the loss of his mother. The main issues discussed centered on nursing and midwifery education, welfare issues of nurses and midwives, Employer and Labour issues as well as Covid-19 related matters.
